Mounting Needlework or Punch Needle in Tin Frames



Materials needed:

- Finished design
- Acid-free Foam Core
- Brass Silk Straight Pins
- Scissors
- Cut foam core just slightly smaller than tin pin opening
- Center finished design over foam core
- Begin pinning, stretching fabric tight, into the sides of the foam core, alternating the pinning on all four sides

NOTE: Most straight pins are just slightly more than one inch long. Our tin pin rectangle is one inch by three

inches. If using this frame, place the pins on the long side slightly at an angle.





- Trim excess fabric, leaving approximately one/half inch around design area.
- Tuck fabric behind foam core and place design in tin pin.
- The corners of the tin pin are not joined, so you can "squeeze" them together!
- ★ Attach the pin backing and wear your new jewelry or make several for gifts this year!
